*FEMA requires separation of the following materials*

Place materials near curb

## CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

Building Materials, Drywall, Lumber,  
Carpet, Furniture, Plumbing

## YARD WASTE

Tree Limbs, Leaves,  
Logs, Plants

## ELECTRONICS

TVs, Stereos, Computers,  
Tablets, Printers

## LARGE APPLIANCES

Refrigerators, Washers,  
Dryers, Water Heaters

## BULKY WASTE

Flood Impacted Furniture,  
Doors, Carpet, Padding

## HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

Bagged Garbage, Discarded Food,  
Packaging (regularly scheduled collection day)

<b>Household Appliances</b> (i.e., air conditioner, dish washer, refrigerator, stove, washer/dryer, water heater)		Scott Area Landfill—11555 110th Ave., Davenport Communities may provide collection
<b>Marine or Waterway Debris</b>		Scott Area Landfill—11555 110th Ave., Davenport Residents require to show proof of ownership to dispose
<b>Metals*</b>		Scott Area Landfill to be recycled —11555 110th Ave., Davenport Communities may provide special collection

<b>Vehicle &amp; Vessels</b>		Scott Area Landfill to be recycled—11555 110th Ave., Davenport Residents require to show proof of ownership to dispose
