EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-~~4~~

PLACING LIMITATIONS ON CITY OF DAVENPORT-OWNED AND NON-LEASED FACILITIES FOR HOBBY & TRADE SHOWS, FUNDRAISERS, ENTERTAINMENT & RECREATIONAL EVENTS, PUBLIC MEETINGS AND OTHER COMMUNITY EVENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT HEALTH AGENCIES & DEPARTMENTS

The President of the United States of America and the Governor of the State of Iowa have determined that a public emergency exists. I reached the same determination that COVID-19 presents a public emergency and that certain prudent, recommended measures should be followed. Accordingly, it is hereby ordered:

Part 1 – Operative Proclamation:

WHEREAS, our Federal, State and Local government health officials are issuing guidelines in order to flatten the curve related to the spread of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the City of Davenport, Iowa owns and operates several facilities that host hobby & trade shows, fundraisers, entertainment & recreation events, public meetings and other community events on a regular basis; and

WHEREAS some events are currently scheduled in these city-owned facilities that are contrary to the prudent advice and recommendation of the local health experts;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that any event described above that exceeds Federal, State or Local government health guidelines related to COVID-19 outbreak shall not be held or limited to the most restrictive guideline. It, of course, is requested that the City Administrator and her staff work to reschedule these events, if possible, to a future date.

Part 2 – Effective date and duration

This order takes effect immediately and shall remain in effect until 12:00:00 A.M. on May 4, 2020 unless earlier revoked or extended.
