#### **DPD and Supporting Agencies Actively Investigating Missing Child Case** Law enforcement asks that volunteer search parties call 9-1-1 with information.

Sat, July 11, 2020 4:30 PM (Davenport, Iowa) - The Davenport Police Department and supporting law enforcement agencies are actively investigating the missing child case of 10-year-old Breasia Terrell who was reported as a missing person on Friday, July 10, 2020. Breasia was last seen in the 2700 block of E 53<sup>rd</sup> Street in the early morning hours wearing a white t-shirt, shorts, and flip-flops. Law enforcement asks that those seeking to join a volunteer search party self-organize as we continue to conduct independent search efforts and are staying in constant contact with the family.

“We are humbled by the outpouring of support. People want to know how they can help,” says Davenport Police Chief Paul Sikorski. “For those who want to volunteer in a search party, we ask that you self-organize groups of three or more for personal safety. These efforts work in tandem with law enforcement efforts but should be lead independently. Any tips or information from volunteers should be called into 9-1-1.”
