#### **DPD and Supporting Agencies Actively Investigating Missing Child Case** Law enforcement asks anyone with information to call 9-1-1.

Mon. July 13, 2020 - The Davenport Police Department is aware of the significant public and social media interest around the missing persons case of 10-year-old Breasia Terrell, and wishes to thank the public for their sincere efforts and assistance as law enforcement continue to investigate. We would like to remind members of the public to report any information relating to the whereabouts of Breasia Terrell by calling 9-1-1 instead of our non-emergency line.

On Friday July 10, 2020, Breasia Terrell was entered into the National Crime Information Center database as missing person. The Davenport Police Department, in conjunction with local law enforcement partners, The Federal Bureau of Investigation, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, and other partners, continue to investigate every possible lead in regards to Breasia's disappearance.

Detectives are in constant contact with her family, and continue to conduct follow-up including k-9 and aerial search and rescue operations, door-to-door canvasses, and following-up on community tips.

We thank everyone for their compassion for the family during this difficult time. As the investigation evolves, we'll be providing updates as soon as possible.
